Baba Fateh Singh Ji

Baba Fateh Singh Ji was the youngest of Guru Gobind Singh Ji and Mata Ajit Kaur Ji's sons. Although Baba Ji was only young in terms of their age, their understanding of Gurbani and Rehat was incomparable to any. They were a master of Shastar Vidiya at the age of 4.

It is said that the tradition of the Akali Nihang Singhs was started by Baba Fateh Singh Ji, and is therefore highly respected by Nihang Singhs all over the world. The tradition of the Farla (Small piece of dastaar, which is left loose by Akali Nihang Singhs to show their Jathedari) was started by Guru Gobind Singh Ji who blessed Baba Fateh Singh Ji and saw the marital spirit that all Sikhs are required to have and maintain.

Baba Ji was desperate to fight alongside his elder brothers, Baba Ajit Singh Ji and Baba Jujhar Singh Ji. Guru Gobind Singh Ji although claimed that because Baba Fateh Singh Ji was too small he was unable to fight in the battle of Chamkaur. Baba Ji left Guru Ji's darbaar and returned some time later with a tall Dumalla. When he returned to Guru Sahib he said: "Maharaj Ji, Sache Patshah! You said I was too small, but look at me now. I'm no longer the small, feeble Fateh Singh. Now I'm just as big as the other Singhs in the fauj!"

Pleased by the efforts shown by Baba Fateh Singh Ji, Guru Sahib blessed them and told them that although he wouldn't be able to fight in this battle, he will still give their life for the Panth and that gursikhs years from now will remember Baba Ji for the sacrifice that he will make. This bachan came true as Baba Ji is remembered all around the world for the amazing courage and determination that he and his older brother Baba Jorawar Singh Ji showed while being bricked alive for not accepting Islam.
